

Repairing cracked grout on a Hearth Pad

Items needed for repair:

Rubber gloves Putty knife Small mixing container Stir stick Sponge

Instructions:

- 1. With a sponge and clean water wipe the surface of pad.
- 2. Locate cracked grout and using a putty knife remove any loose debris.
- 3. For best results scratch the area around the recently removed broken grout with your putty knife, this will increase the surface area for the repair grout to adhere to. Remove any of this loose debris.

4.

- a. In a small mixing container add a portion of the repair grout and a small portion of water, always add water to the grout not grout to water.
- b. Using a stir stick mix until the contents resemble the consistency of creamy peanut butter.
- c. Using your putty knife spread the freshly mixed grout compound into the area where you removed the cracked grout,
- d. Wait about 15 minutes, and clean the area with a sponge and water.

This repair should take about 15 to 20 minutes to complete.
